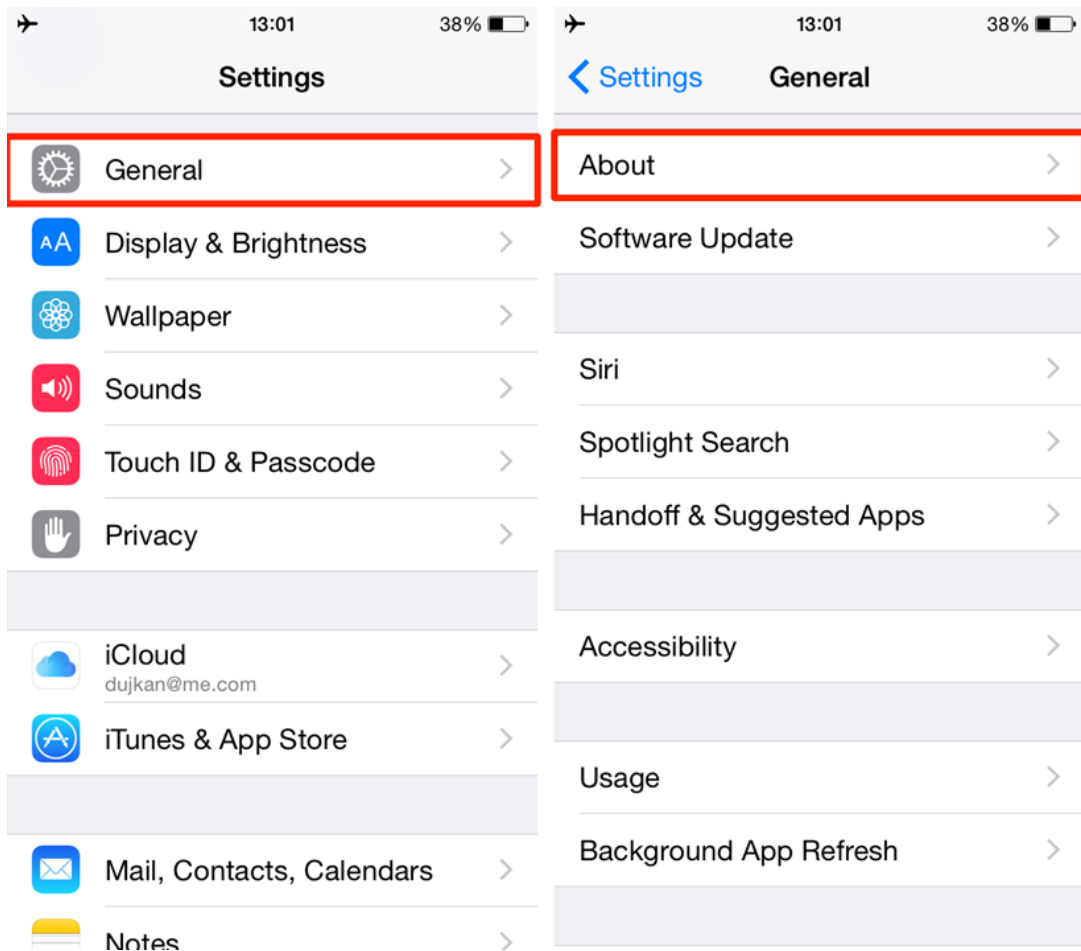


MyGateRemote – Wifi device installation

For iOS smartphones

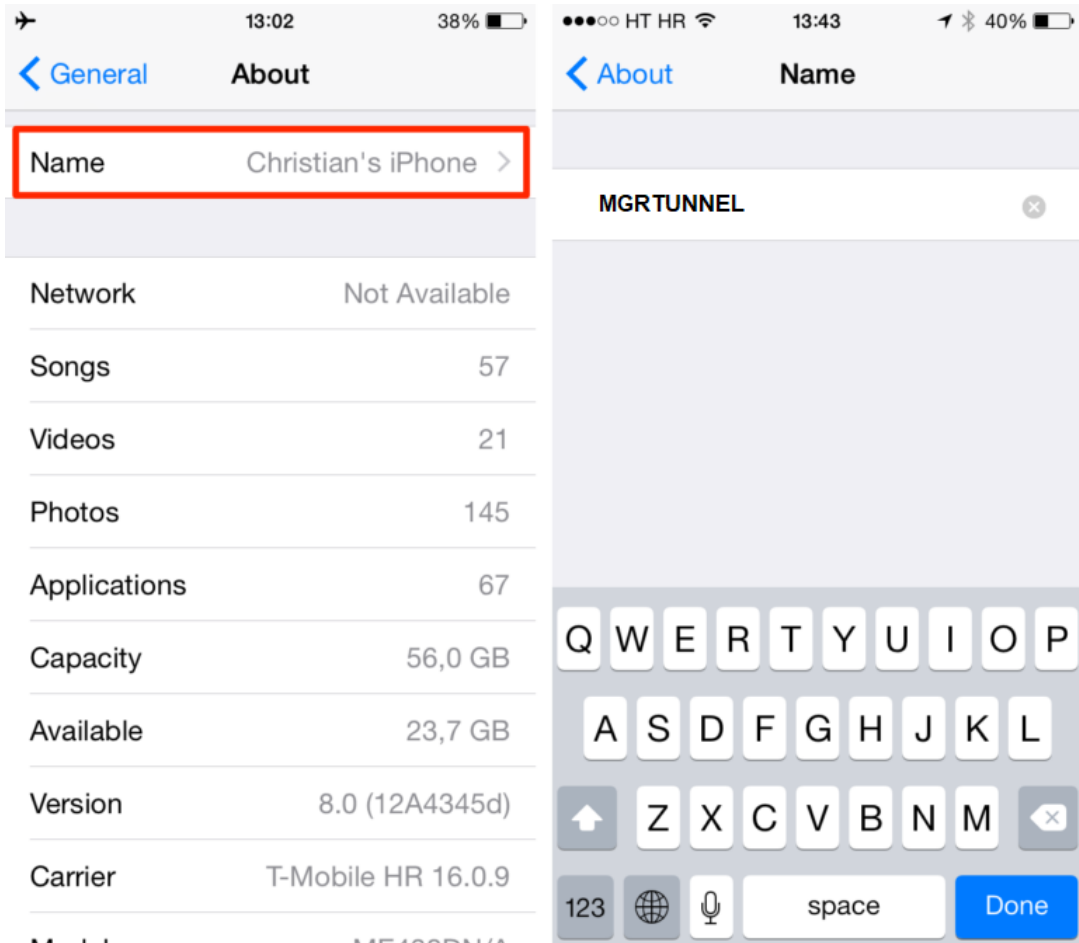
Adding your Device

- Got to <https://www.mygateremote.com>
- Click the **LOGIN** Button (it will be at the top right)
- Log in with your details, if you have not yet registered click the **SIGN UP** button and register your details, you will be sent an email with a link to confirm your email address, click on the link to confirm and then you can return and login.
- Once logged in you will see a list of devices if you have any, otherwise the list will be blank, Click the **ADD A DEVICE OR TOKEN** button
- Put the Serial Number of your Device (you will find it as a number stuck on the button of your MyGateRemote device)
- Put in the name of the entrance that this device will open (e.g. Main Gate)
- Click the **ADD** button.
- The Device should now appear in your list of devices.
- You will now need to set the devices Wi-Fi connection details in order for this device to connect through your Wi-Fi, the factory setting is to connect to a Wi-Fi called MGR TUNNEL with a password of 123456789. You can use your smartphone to setup a Wi-Fi Hotspot with these details and then change the setting of the device to the Wi-Fi you want it to connect to. In the next section we show you how to setup a hotspot on your iOS device



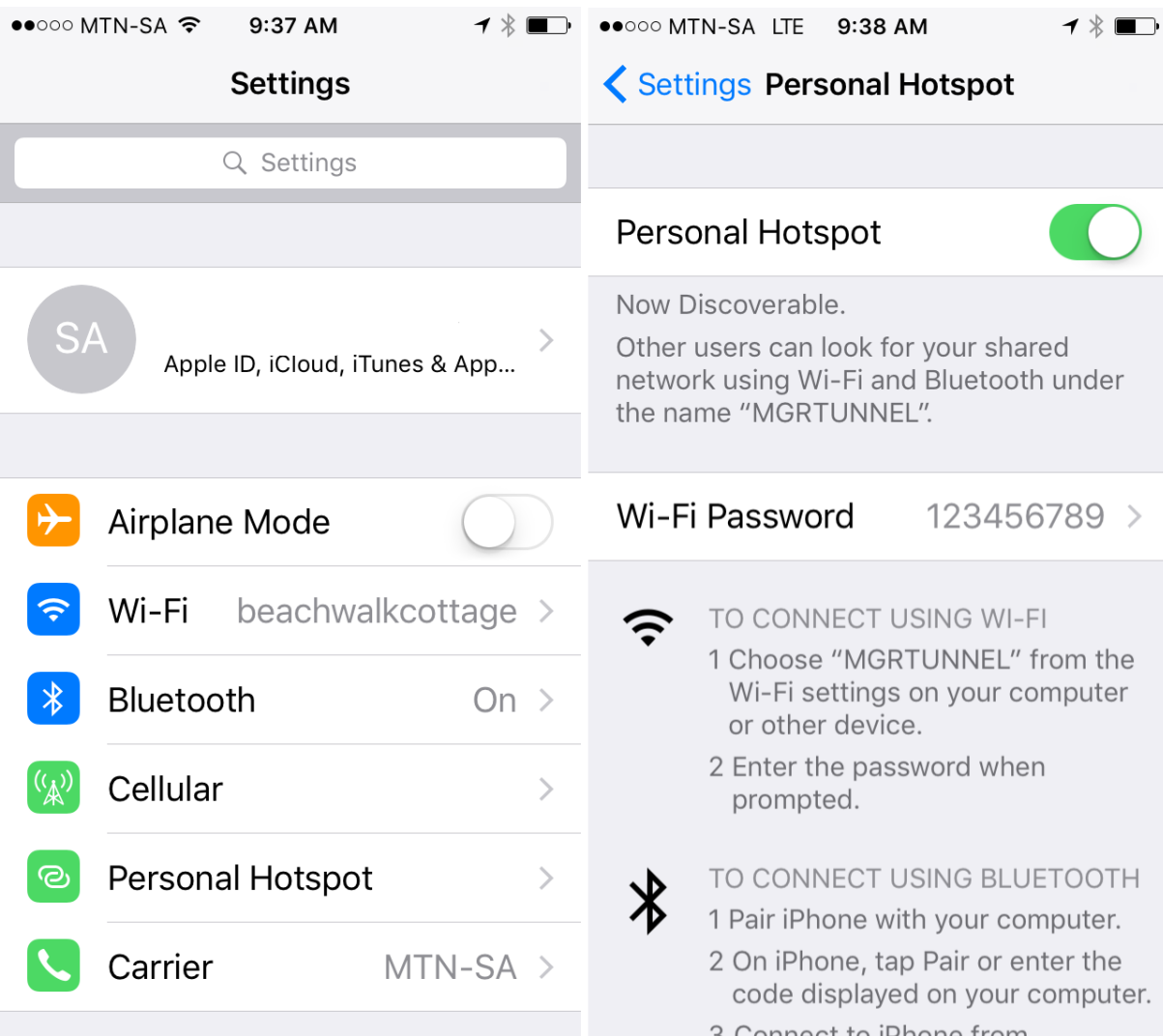
Wifi Hotspot – iOS (Step 1)

- Launch the Settings app on your device and navigate to General > About



Wifi Hotspot – iOS (Step 2)


- As pictured left, the Name section at the very top should display the current name of your iPhone, iPad or iPod touch. Tap it to set a custom name for your device.
- Use the on-screen keyboard to give the device a new name. Hit Done when finished. In the example left, I renamed my iPhone 5s from the default “Christan’s iPhone” name “MGR TUNNEL”.




Wifi Hotspot – iOS (Step 3)

- Go back to the main Settings screen, then into Personal Hotspot (If Personal Hotspot is not available here, then it will be in the Cellular menu).
- Move the slider button so that the Personal hotspot is turned on. Make sure you set the Wi-Fi password to 123456789
- Wait until you see 1 connection appear at the top of this screen, this will be the MyGateRemote device connecting.
- Once the device has connected through your Personal Hotspot, the red light (look through the hole in the top of the device) will stop flashing and remain on.
- Once the light is on, go to the next section to add the device.

Configure Your Device

- In the phone browser (or a PC browser) go to <https://client.mygateremote.com>
- Login with your email and password that you registered with.
- Click on the device you added earlier to select it.
- Click the menu button  and select the [Wi-Fi menu option](#).
- Set the “Wi-Fi SSID Name” (the name of your router)
- Set the Wifi Password.
- Click the [SET WIFI Button](#) and it should indicate it was changed successfully.
- Turn Off the Personal Hotspot on your mobile phone (follow the instructions earlier but turn it OFF this time)
- The Device should reboot and connect to the Wi-fi you have setup.
- Look through the hole in the enclosure and you should the green LED on now and no longer flashing.

Test the Device has connected

- In the phone browser (or a PC browser) go to <https://client.mygateremote.com>
- Login with your email and password that you registered with.
- Click on the device you added earlier
- Click the menu button  and select the Test Communication option.
- Click the **PING DEVICE** Button and you should see a message indicating success.
- If you get an error indication, wait a while (a minute or so) and try the Ping again.
- If you still do not get a successful Ping then repeat these instructions from “Wifi Hotspot – iOS ”
- If you get a successful Ping then you can click the main Activation button and the Gate/Garage/Lock...etc. should activate.
